

Websterville Baptist Christian School 2009/2010 Dress Code

Preschool

All students in Preschool are expected to dress appropriately for school. Shorts and long pants are allowed for girls and boys. Girls dresses and skirts should be of modest length. Clothing should be free of slogans, advertisements, suggestive pictures, writing, sensuous prints, faddish styles/colors and other things that would detract from the academic and spiritual process of Websterville Baptist Christian School. Undershirts should not be worn as outerwear. Girls are not to wear halter tops. Biker shorts should not be worn as shorts. No flip flops or thongs should be worn. Boys hair is to be above the ear and off the collar and eyebrows.

Girls Dress Code

Girls in grades K-12 may choose from the following items:

- Dress or Skirt —Any solid color (must be at least knee length and not form fitting)**
- Peter Pan Shirt —long or short sleeve (White/Yellow/Lt.Blue/Red)**
- Polo Shirt —long or short sleeve (no writing is allowed on the shirt)**
- Turtleneck (any solid color)**
- Docker style pants (Khaki/Navy/Gray/Black/ Brown)**
- Corduroy pants (Khaki/Navy/Gray/Black/Brown)**
- Docker Style Shorts (Khaki/Navy/Gray/Black/Brown)**
- Capri Pants (Khaki/Navy/Gray/Black/Brown)**

***Solid color jumpers or skirts may be purchased from Harvey uniforms, JC Penney or any where that deals in school uniforms.*

****We require that belts be worn with pants or shorts. Students may not use rope, string etc as a belt.****

*****Polo Shirts may not be unbuttoned more than two buttons and must not be tight or form fitting.*

******Patch pockets are acceptable on pants, but cargo pants will not be allowed.*

******Carharrrt brand pants or shorts may not be worn.****

Boys Dress Code

Boys in grades K-12 may choose from the following items:

Dress Shirt—long or short sleeve

Polo Shirt— long or short sleeve (no writing is allowed on the shirt)

Turtleneck Shirt (any solid color)

Docker Style Pants (Khaki/Navy/Gray/Black/Brown)

Corduroy Pants (Khaki/Navy/Gray/Black/Brown)

Docker style shorts (Khaki/Navy/Gray/Black/Brown)

All of the above items may be purchased at any department store

****Patch pockets are acceptable on pants, but cargo pants may not be worn.*

General Dress Code information and description

Docker style shorts and pants—Docker style pants are cotton twill pants that have slit pockets in the back. They may or may not have pleats in the front. Shorts must also be Docker style which are longer in length. Shorts may be worn year round. Girls may wear pants year round as well. ***Guys and Girls may wear Patch Pocket style pants or shorts. These pants may not be jean material or any color different than allowed. Carhartt brand pants may not be worn.***

Peter Pan shirts— These must be cotton shirts that button up the front and have round collars.

Sports Team Wear— The Jr/Sr High sports teams may wear dress clothing on game days. This would include a shirt and a tie for men and a dress, skirt or pant suit for women. The dress or skirt must be knee length. If the clothing does not meet the modesty standard, the student may be sent home at the discretion of the administrator.

Sweaters—Any sweater or cardigan may be worn. All sweaters, other than turtleneck sweaters, must be worn with a polo shirt or turtleneck underneath. Sweaters with hoods are acceptable. Sweatshirts may not be worn at any time in the classroom. A fleece vest is acceptable to wear in place of a sweater. ***Students may wear sweatshirts with Brand Name Logos as jackets only. These may not be worn in the classroom.***

Gold Polo shirts—All students in grades K-6 are required to wear gold polo shirts on school field trips. Gold polo shirts may be worn on any other school day as well. You may purchase a gold polo shirt with the school monogram by contacting the school office.

Coats—Jackets may not be worn in the classroom at any time. The only exception will be a suit jacket worn over a dress shirt.

Turtlenecks—Students may wear turtlenecks and long or short sleeve t-shirts under the polo shirts. These must be tucked in.

**** Please note as of August 2006, students in grades K-6 are required to tuck shirts in their pants or shorts. Students in grades 7-12 do not have to tuck polo shirts in their pants or shorts. All dress shirts must be tucked in. ****

The dress code is enforced at all times. Unless otherwise specified, students are to comply with the dress code while attending school and when attending all school functions, activities or trips. **Students in grades 7-12 may not change clothes at school during the day or at the end of the school day without administrative permission.**
