Traffic Pattern: A copy of the traffic pattern for picking up and dropping off children is posted on the back of this newsletter. All students in grades K - 6 are to be picked up in the main parking lot. All students in grades 7-12 must be picked up next to Collin's Hall. Any Jr/Sr High student with a younger sibling may be picked up in the main driveway and must stand next to the picnic table on the front lawn until the parent arrives. Following this plan will greatly reduce the likelihood of tragedy.

Student Pick Up: When you are picking up your children, please do not allow them to play on the basketball court before 3:00 PM. The parking lot is congested at that time and could result in an accident. Although I believe it is very important for parents to play with their children, I encourage you to promptly leave with your children when picking them up at the end of the day. Unfortunately, when we have children staying after being signed out, it creates a disruption among the other students under our care.

Extended Care: Any student in grades K -6, who is staying for extended care must be picked up in the library. Preschool may be picked up at the preschool building.
