WBCS Closing/Late Opening Policy and Procedure

- **In the event school will be closed for any reason, the decision will be made prior to 6:00 AM. Each teacher will be called through the phone tree after the decision originates from the Administration. The closing will be announced on the local radio stations and the Channel 3 News.**

- **In the event it becomes necessary to delay the opening of school, school will begin at 10:00 AM. During a delayed opening, all Faculty and Staff should arrive as soon as they are able, but before students are allowed to enter the building. No student will be allowed into the building until 9:45 AM. Each student in grades 7-12 will go to their homeroom from 10:00 – 10:07 and will begin 3rd period at 10:10. The delayed opening will be announced as a two-hour delay on the local radio stations and the Channel 3 News.**
